SUPERINTENDENT'S CORNER

March was a very busy month at Colony Creek! Tournament season started off in full swing with a couple of big tournaments and several high school/college events. We had some wonderful golfing weather throughout this past month, a far cry from the two hard freezes we made it through to start the year. A little more rain would have been appreciated to help us as the grass begins to grow, but I'm sure we will see some soon enough! The warmer weather has had our team working on more mowing and weed eating than we have since last fall. Not only was the grass starting to grow, but the weeds started too as well. Our short grasses have stayed mostly clear of weed coverage up to this point which means our fall pre-emergence application went well in those areas. We did notice a lot of clover and some other broadleaf weeds in the rough, so next Fall I believe I can make some tweaks to pre-emerge to keep that from happening again. I spent a fair amount of time on the sprayer this last month knocking down those weeds and saw some good success. Towards the end of the month, we were also able to get down some fertilizer and pre-emergent applications to prepare our grass for the growing season. April is always a busy month in the turfgrass management world, and this one looks to be no different! Between golf tournaments and events, we have many cultural practices planned to improve our turfgrass conditions. Towards the end of this next month, I will hit my 1 year anniversary of being the Golf Course Superintendent for The Club at Colony Creek. I am proud of how far we have come in my first year, and yet there is still much work to be accomplished to give the members the best golf course that we can. We can't wait for what year 2 has in store!


